The ConVal VPAC organization is excited to announce a new, important component in the campaign to reach its financial goals. Online donating capability for the public's use has been added to its website. A user-friendly software program, Qgiv, has been installed for online donors.

Currently, there are two pressing financial needs. Funds are required for an architectural feasibility study, which will determine the suitability of the center's proposed site (behind ConVal High School) and provide an estimate for the total cost of the building with furnishings. Secondly, a financial feasibility/fundraising consultant must be retained to assess financial feasibility and guide fundraising efforts.

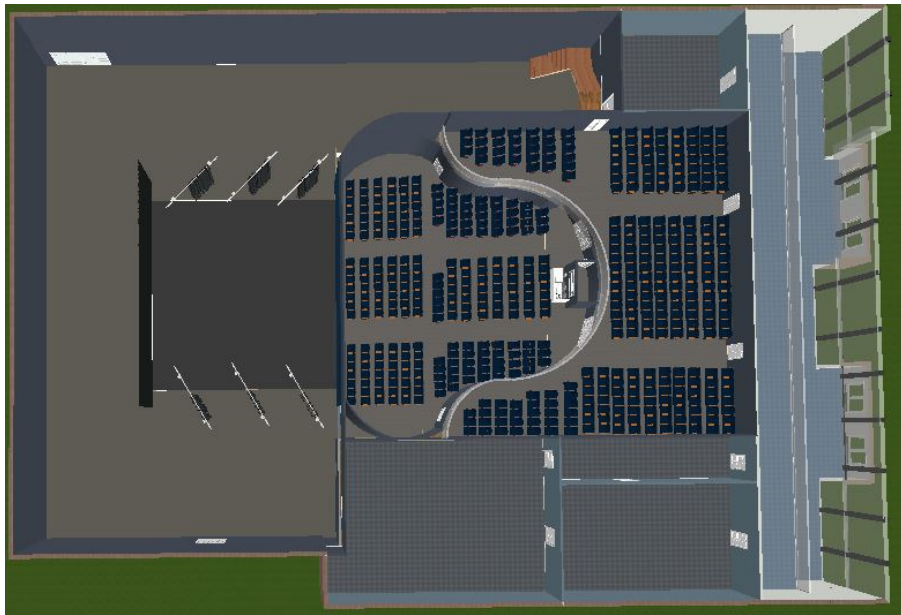
